- Organise a series of 6 evenings for another section on an international theme.

This section is about developing your knowledge and skills and then putting them into practice to make a real difference / have an impact on your local community.

- Research and participate in a local environmental or community-based project to make an improvement in the environment or community.
- Run the Environmental Conservation Activity Badge for the cubs / Scouts.
- Research and volunteer at a local charity (Separate to your volunteering for DofE)
- Run the staged community impact staged badge for a different section.
